Associate members are individuals who have paid full dues and are members in good standing at another lawn bowling club and wish to participate in our Club's programs. Upon recommendation of the Membership Chair, an associate member may participate as described in their application. They shall not be entitled to the rights, privileges, and prerogatives of Club members, and shall not have the right to vote, hold office, or to have any proprietary interest in the Club's assets.	Junior members are individuals between 9 and 19 years of age who have paid the appropriate full current Junior membership fees, and who are not under suspension. They are entitled to participate in all activities of the Club. They shall enjoy all the rights, privileges, and prerogatives of Club membership, except the right to vote, to hold office and to have any proprietary interest in the Club's assets.
